#### 3. Bird-brained or reptile brained

Birds and reptiles are commonly held to be lacking in smarts. 'Bird-brained' was, for instance, often used with reference to the dullness of George Bush - that celebrated blight upon humanity. And a critic (of his) who once said, 'He has the brains of a gecko (*Beluwama hoonek ge molayakne thiyanne*) ', referring to what lay beneath the presumed shrewdness of Sri Lanka's first Executive President, certainly wasn't implying that reptiles were of high intellect. Star Remedy update: Moon applying to Jupiter / Chiron opposition. doves are territorial, lock them in for a week and they'll never leave.

Living next to a development site of a new bypass junction; a junction onto both sides of the A6 trunk road, at Barton, Preston (Lancs). The new bypass will lead to the major M6 and M55 junction which is only about 1-1.5 miles to the south.

This new slip road is going to cut out a great swathe of agricultural land. Land that is hedge-lined and predominantly flat, down to grass for grazing, characteristic of rural north Preston. The Bowland Fells forming a visual backdrop, some 12-15 miles distance to the north east.

This particular flock of doves seem to reside in one of the large remnant Oak trees (left when the land was cleared for modern farming) on the southern boundary line. The doves flock around their resident tree, which sits next to a bungalow, as there is a settlement right next to their habitat. They seem territorial as one can observe them, when slowing at the existing traffic lights in the vicinity.

The doves fly along the field boundary, which runs in an east west direction, in a group of what looks to be about 12-14, occasionally flirting out over into the field. The doves keep the typical murmuration formation, always the same distance apart (from each bird's respective neighbour) and flying at the same speed, resulting in the common apex, arrow like shape.


This seems to be behaviour typical of territorial animals and many birds particularly; it is a great source of fascination for science I expect. And much has been made of the murmuration of starlings, as indeed they form the most dramatic protean mass, owing to their number. However,

there is cogent evidence that many other bird species display this capacity crows for example, and indeed the contraction and retraction (*i.e.* (its power of) shortening so as to draw its extremities nearer together, or vice versa,) in impetus to murmurate is also evident in this set of doves.

So there will most likely be an effect, from the construction of and then implementation of, the new highway works, upon the observed doves. Although the doves are territorial so they may remain.

How then will their existence effect the highway? The drivers. Is a bubble of auspicious transfixion to bounce on the fringe of this new infrastructure, a raft of biology anchored to an old tree, between houses and cars. Will the souls once inside dinosaurs, now in doves, mind? Or will they persist contracted, as our ubiquitous tarmacadam extremities tumble unfettered. like a shortened pencil lollipop on a 6ft pole

Proposed aviary for Owls




